Thank you very much for the interesting information you sent me about Dennis' Great Grandfather, Patrick Fletcher.

Dennis and I have in recent times spent holidays in the U.K tracing the history of the Jura Fletchers. We visited Jura and stayed in the original Fletcher homestead in Craighouse (now an Inn) where we were very fortunate to meet up with local historian, who had chapter and verse about the Fletchers of Jura

We also visited Argyllshire, where we met up with a distant cousin. She was able to give much information on the Fletchers in general, including some on Patrick Fletcher's youngest son, Sir Angus Somerville Fletcher of the U.S.A. born in Queenstown, S.A., and buried at Dalnally Parish Church.

We have been to the Archives in Cape Town and to the Krusna Library and Museum to find out more about Patrick's career in South Africa. The information you have now provided has been of much value and has opened up some more leads.

We have only wall sized portraits of Patrick and Agnes Fletcher, but will get these photographed, so that we can send you a copy and perhaps one might be appreciated hanging in the Millwood Museum. Will contact you again when the photographs are ready.
